

Research Institute for Electronic Science, Hokkaido University  
2026 Research Students  
—Application Guidelines—

Providing that there are no obstacles barring admission, applicants who have passed the Research Institute for Electronic Science Council' s screening shall be admitted as research students to work on specific topics of research.

### 1. Eligibility Requirements

(1) Applicants must have completed an undergraduate program.

Or

(2) Applicants that are recognized as having equal or greater academic achievements as persons in category (1) above.

### 2. Admission Period • Research Period

(1) Admission Periods: April or October 2026 (However, this shall not apply under special circumstances)

(2) Research Period: 1 year (if there are special circumstances a term less than 1 year is possible)

※ Extension for continuing research can be approved after completing the proper procedure. If the continuing research is under the same title, tuition is charged, but screening and admission fees are not.

#### 4. Online Application Procedures

You must pay the screening fee through the online application system and submit the application documents.

<Application process is as follows.>

- 1) The approval from the supervisor.
- 2) Contact the Research Cooperation Section Northern Campus Area Joint Administration Hokkaido University (k-kenkyo@jimu.hokudai.ac.jp) and receive a site address and ID required to use the online application system.
- 3) Pay the screening fee through the online application system.  
You can also complete the application form by filling out the form.
- 4) Send the application documents to the Northern Campus Area Joint Administration (see below).

#### 5. Documents to Submit

Application Forms	Remarks
① Research student (and continuing student) application.	Only the form provided by the Institute will be accepted. Before submitting your application, please get the approval of your prospective advisor.
②Curriculum vitae	Commercially available forms accepted. Please attach an identification photo.
③ Copy of a diploma(or graduation certificate) from the highest school graduated.	Applicants who have not graduated from a university must submit documents detailing their research background.
④Screening fee	See 6. <i>Expenditures</i> below
⑤Residence Card or copy of passport ※ only applicants that are foreign nationals	• Applicants residing in Japan must submit a Foreign Residence Card. • Applicants who do not live in Japan must submit a copy of their passport.
⑥ Approval form for entrance (or continuing admission ) as a research student.	Only the form provided by the Institute will be accepted. Applicants currently employed at a company, etc. must get the approval of their immediate director.

- (1) In case of withdrawal midway through the research period, please apply to the Director of the Research Institute for Electronic Science one month before the expected withdrawal date (please submit the designated Withdrawal Form).

Regardless of withdrawal during the semester, tuition for that period must be paid in full.

- (2) An international student may request to change the date of admission if he or she cannot enter Japan before the date of admission due to a delay in the issuance of a certificate of eligibility for reasons not attributable to the student himself/herself or due to immigration restrictions imposed by the Japanese government.
